## **Party Guidelines**

- Pool parties must be scheduled a minimum of two (2) weeks in advance and cannot exceed 4 hours.
- Pool parties may not take place on opening weekend, holidays (Memorial Day, July 4<sup>th</sup>, Labor Day), or entire association party/event days.
- No two (2) pool parties can be scheduled at the same time or overlap. Two (2) parties may be scheduled on the same day with a minimum of a half (1/2) hour between starting/ending times. (Party A 11AM-2PM, Party B 2:30PM 6PM, etc.)
- A pool party is not confirmed until you receive a confirmation e-mail or telephone call from a member of the Absolute Pool Management supervisory team. (Lead Guard, or LG Supervisor)
- Additional single lifeguard coverage is required for every party with 25 people in attendance or subject to high usage times at the pool. Each additional 10 people in attendance at the party necessitate another lifeguard up to but no more than 50 guests. *The charges for each Lifeguard is \$30 per hour with a minimum of 2 hours.*
- The number of people guideline is based on total party attendees not estimated swimmers. This means that if your party will have 50 persons attending and only 20 are going to swim the party sponsor will still need 3-lifeguards minimum to meet the number of attending people for the party.
- **The party sponsor is responsible for party clean**. An extra charge will be assessed for extra clean up time that extends after the scheduled pool party hours.
- Please submit the pool party request form to the lead lifeguard at your HOA pool.
